State Convention

This is a two-day convention that gives our members a chance to meet hundreds of other Junior Beta members from schools throughout Georgia and participate in activities ranging from academic contests to quiz bowls to talent competitions. The State Convention provides the opportunity for members to interact, share project ideas, and showcase their academic and leadership abilities. The State Convention is a fun-filled two days that our members look forward to each year.

WBMS Junior Beta Club requirements are as follows:

Students must have an average of 93+ in the four academic subjects (Language Arts, Social Studies, Math, Science) and maintain at least a Satisfactory conduct grade (C2).

If the student's average falls below 93, he/she will be placed on probation for the following semester. If the 93 average is not attained at the end of the probationary period, he/she is removed from membership with the club.

**** Your Jr. Beta membership in 5th grade does not roll over to 6th grade. 6th graders who meet eligibility requirements will receive an invitation at the end of the 1st semester of 6th grade to join WBMS Jr. Beta.***
